<u>Treasurer's Report</u>: Herb Sharpless reported:

- P & L looks good, with Net Income of \$6,200 for 2020.
- Bank statements are in order.
- Will still file postcard version of Form 990 with IRS since revenue is under \$50K. We are getting closer to threshold that would require a more substantial filing.
- No questions asked.
- A motion was made to approve the Treasurer's Report (Don Henderson), seconded (Jim Corcoran) and approved by the Directors.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Fish: Jim "Corky" Corcoran reported:

• Very successful Fishapalooza held on Saturday, February 6th. Plenty of ice. 111 anglers enrolled and approximately 30 fish weighed in with pictures of texts of

sizes submitted to Corky. Largest caught was a 34" Northern Pike. No "afterparty" held due to COVID.

- The Kids Fish Jamboree will be held the 3rd weekend in July July 17th based on appropriate COVID protocols.
- 2017 was the last time we stocked walleye and it's not clear if the State Centennial program will provide any this year. Due to delays from COVID, we probably will not have a comprehensive fish survey in 2021. There is some natural reproduction but due to limited habitat for walleye we may need to stock them this year.

<u>Water Quality</u>: Debbie Ferrari reported for Dave DeAngelis:

• The only thing I have to report are the ICE ON dates: 12/27/20 for Mill and Middle Lakes and 12/29/20 for Green Lake.

<u>Communications:</u> Debbie Ferrari reported:

- Spring ShoreLines will be coming in April, and sent to the entire Lake District.
- Please send any photos you may have ASAP.

<u>Membership:</u> Debbie Ferrari reported:

- As of this date, there are 708 members which is an all time record high.
- Printer in Delavan will complete entire printing, stuffing & mailing process within budgeted amount. Additional cost of them handling mailing is offset by reduced postage.
- Membership letters will be sent to 705 members and 728 non-members, which includes the entire Lake District.
- "Due Date" is April 15th.

<u>Planning & Zoning:</u> Don Henderson reported:

Public Boat Launches

- Total fees collected during the 2020 Season were \$24,500. The COVID 19 pandemic apparently created an increase of \$6,000 in boating over 2019.
- Town expenses maintaining and improving the Four Launch Ramps and related maintenance of piers, buoys, signs, porta potties, parking etc. totaled \$33,558.

- One large expense of \$12,400 was replacing concrete pavement and improving the drain at the Sterlingworth Bay Ramp.
- Town is planning to repave the West Shore Boat Launch Ramp driveway area during the summer of 2021.

Town Board Election

• Three supervisors running in the spring election are incumbents Don Sukala, Mark Bromley and John Anderson.

Lauderdale-LaGrange Fire Department

- The Department currently has 37 members and 26 are trained in either DMR or EMT.
- Firefighters express their sincere appreciation of the financial support from the community, which donated \$22,730 in support of the cancelled spring dance, and \$44,730 in support of the cancelled Steak Fry.
- These funds are being used to purchase materials and build the new training building now under construction behind the new Town Highway Garage across from the Fire Station.

DNR Public Hearing

- DNR Public Hearing for Stan Smith Request for a six-slip pier in the sensitive extremely shallow north side of Middle Lake was held virtually on Friday February 19. Several LLIA members spoke in opposition to this permanent 60-foot-long tee shape proposed pier.
- The DNR will decide probably in June or July this year.

Speed Limits for roads around the lakes

• The proposed 25 mph speed limit has been sent to WI DOT for review.

- April meeting includes Officer elections. There will be voting on a new President and Vice President per LLIA bylaws. - We need to start brainstorming for projects under our Lake Preservation Fund.

New Business

• The DNR held a public hearing for the 70' pier in the sensitive area on Middle Lake, which was opposed by the LLIA. Many attended which helped the cause.

Lake organizations and the Town of LaGrange have a good relationship and Town was support of our opposition.

- Jane Larsen brought up that landowners are putting too many boats on moorings and in front of their home. If you see something like this, please report it to the Town of LaGrange.
- The Pier Ordinance is being reviewed by the Lake District, which will forward a recommendation to the Town of LaGrange.
- The next LLIA Director meeting will be April 24th at 9am, via Zoom.
- June 12th is the Annual Membership Meeting. A poll was taken to determine if Directors were in favor of an in person meeting. 100% were in favor of holding some form of in person meeting. We will decide whether it will be held in the cafeteria at Lutherdale or outdoors in the Pavilion. This will be a socially distanced meeting.

LLLMD Update: Debbie Ferrari reported there have been no recent LLLMD meetings.

<u>KMLT Update</u>: Herb Sharpless reported for Dave DeAngelis:

- ShoreLines article about Petersen Island Woods Preserve state the new trail is now open. You are now able to walk on the trail instead of the road, which is much safer.
- New program manager at KMLT is Rachel, who is from East Troy.
- Kathryn Calkins has joined the KMLT Board.
- KMLT is starting a internship for High School students; it will be run this summer.
